

Colorado Unemployment Insurance Benefits Information

Unemployment insurance benefits are available to unemployed workers who meet the eligibility requirements of Colorado law.

To file a claim, eligible individuals can:

Call: Colorado Division of Unemployment Insurance at 303-318-9000 or 1-800-388-5515 if you are located outside the Denver metro area. If you are hearing impaired, please call 303-318-9016 or 1-800-894-7730.

To file a claim, you will need to provide information about any work you have performed since January 2020, including the name and address of the business, dates you worked, and rate of pay. Income-related information can be found on your pay stubs.

Once a claim is filed online, you can log into your MyUI+ account on the Colorado Department of Labor and Education website to view the status of your claim.
